- Conduct in-person ADA assessments of existing active CATS Paratransit clients and to evaluate the physical and/or cognitive abilities and visual abilities to use CATS in compliance with the ADA paratransit eligibility criteria.
- Conduct and provide travel training for CATS customers who the Contractor identifies as possible rides of the CATS fix route system on a trip by trip basis.
